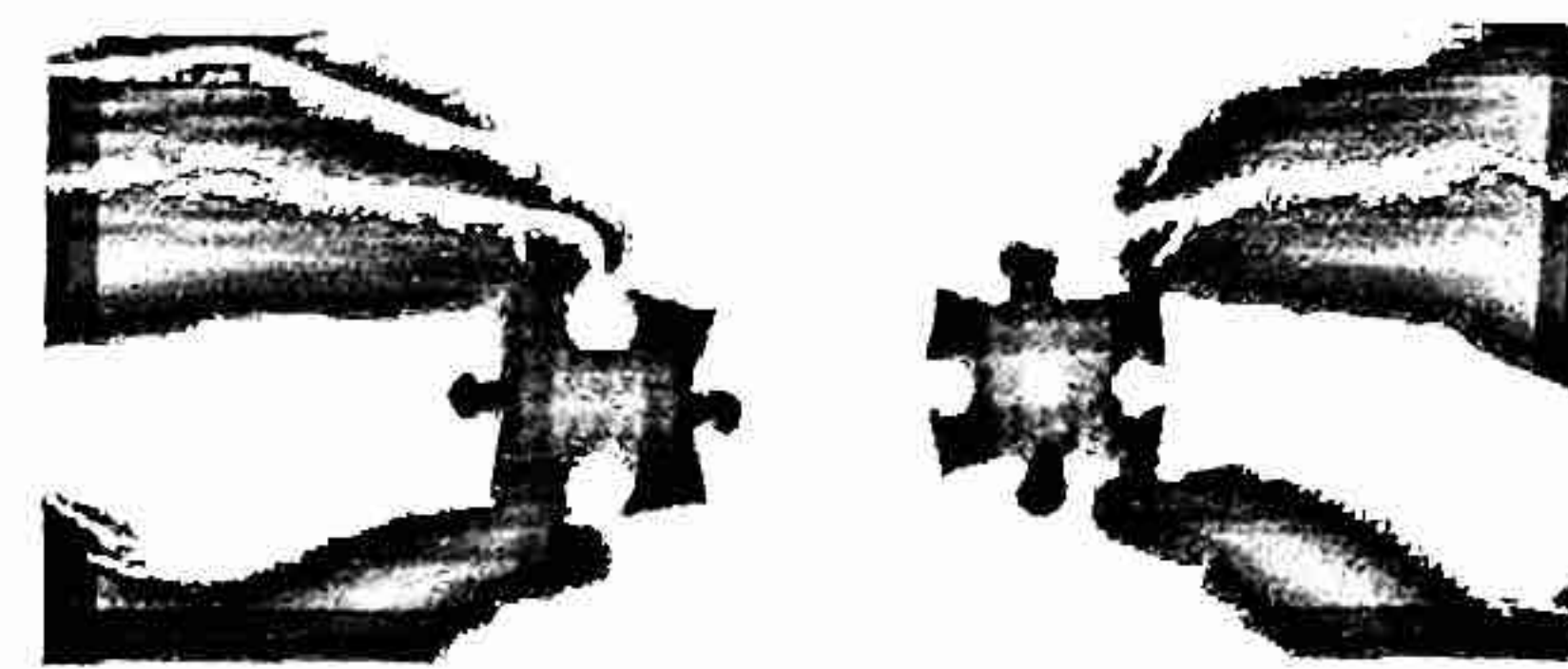

Clinic Info:

The Center for Psychotherapies is a community resource for mental health treatment of individuals with a wide variety of issues. Psychotherapy, also known as "talk therapy," is a term for various treatment techniques to help a person identify and change troubling emotions, thoughts, and behaviors. This is a resident-run clinic, which means all of the doctors have graduated medical school and are in training to become independent psychiatrists. They meet with supervisors to assist in guiding your treatment plan.

Clinic Policies:

Becoming a patient – Following your initial appoint (called "intake"), you and your assigned therapist will schedule your appointments together. We request patients to commit to meeting *weekly* or *biweekly*.

Clinic hours – Our clinic is open Wednesday afternoons, Thursdays, and Fridays.

Insurance – We accept many forms of insurance. Unfortunately, we are unable to see patients with the following insurance plans at this time:
Managed Health Medicaid, Network Health Plan Medicaid, Tricare, Common Ground Envision, Molina Marketplace, Empathia, Interplan Health Group (IHG), North Central Healthcare Alliance

Fees – The initial intake appointment fee is \$80. Follow-up therapy sessions are \$15 and sessions with medication management may be \$40.

No show/late-cancellation policy – The policy varies depending on provider. Please try to cancel appointments at least 24 hours before your scheduled time. Multiple no-shows may result in discharge from the clinic.
